Welcome to this very special service of worship! Today's service focuses upon the Rite of Confirmation.



A person is incorporated into the universal church, the body of Christ, through the sacrament of baptism. When an infant or very young child is baptized, one or more parents and/or sponsors make the baptismal promises. These adult Christians assume certain responsibilities for the Christian nurture of the baptized child. The entire congregation also assumes a role in this ministry of nurture as its members promise to provide a supportive Christian community in which a child may grow in awareness and understanding concerning the meaning of life in Christ.

As a child who was baptized in infancy approaches adolescence, the local church offers that person the opportunity to give public assent to the baptismal promises. Confirmation celebrates this occasion of affirmation of baptism in the life of the individual and of the local church.

Today's service will also include Communion. The invitation and the call to the supper emphasize that all people of faith are welcome at Christ's table. The invitation and call celebrates not only the memory of a meal in the past, but an actual meal with the risen Christ that is a foretaste of the heavenly banquet at which Christ will preside at the end of history.

The order of today's service is an adaptation of two services taken from the United Church of Christ Book of Worship; Brief Order for the Service of Word and Sacrament and The Order for Confirmation.
